What does virtual education entail?

To be successful in our program, the student must have access to a computer and the internet. Families of full-time students in our **Osceola Virtual School (K-12 program)** may be eligible to receive a computer, if they qualify.

How to enroll?

- Valid Parent Driver's License or State Identification
- Child's Birth Certificate
- Mortgage or Lease Agreement
- Current Utility Bill
- Current Physical Examination (Must be from Doctor)
- Immunization Records
- Osceola Virtual School Agreement found on our school website

Please keep in mind that Florida has eligibility requirements per Section 1002.455, Florida Statute, and not all options may be available to your child.
